

# New Zealand wetsalted woolly lamb skins

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## Grade C

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### Pelt Specification:

New Zealand Skin Selection:	New Season woolly lambs
Grades:	First & Second Grades
Length:	85 cm and up
Shape:	Misshapen skins acceptable.
Holes and exposed flay cuts:	Maximum of 3 faults within 100 of pelt edge. Exposed flay and holes in neck area provided pelt length is 85 cm up
Other:	No Seed, Light Rib

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### Wool Specification:

Wool Count:	48 to 58's
Wool length:	45 to 100 mm
Wool Style:	<b>1) Main panel:</b> Good style. Slightly 'empty' or 'open broader' wool types acceptable. Good condition wool. No matted or broken wool. <b>2) Belly area:</b> Tender wool and light matting acceptable.
Crutching:	In butt, provided a minimum pelt length of 85 cm is achievable after trimming to still give a reasonably balanced shaped skin. In belly, to a maximum of 50 mm each side.
Wool colour:	Medium weather staining. Black fibre in legs. Small black fibre spots. Heavy raddle acceptable.
Other:	No grass seed, however Bathurst burr acceptable. No dermatitis.

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
